Here in the Library Media Center, we have been busy with using our research models. With the recent weather happenings and holiday, different classes are at different points in the process. We are working hard to get everyone on the same page! Kinder students are working their tiny tails off with learning how to login independently. If you are a kinder parent, ask your student what their 6-digit student ID number is to login to a school computer! This is one of the major keys to logging in successfully.

First grade through fourth grade are working on their researching skills through connection in their IB units. Fifth grade is steady rockin' with gathering information for their Exhibition. In first through third grade, we have been focusing on the resource, "www.worldbookonline.com" and looking at how we can navigate it to find information efficiently. At the end of this blurb, provided will be the username and password that can give students access to the resource on their computers and devices at home! Fourth and fifth graders are focusing their research using the ProQuest Database (located through District Learning Apps on the Clover Park School District Website through the Student tab). The username and password is the same as such for www.worldbookonline.com and will be provided below.

Testing is around the corner! As third through fifth graders are preparing for the test season in the upcoming months, improving their typing skills can be extremely beneficial to their success. With the time (or lack of) to work on typing in library class, working on typing skills outside of library is important. Encourage your student(s) log in to the Clever Portal and use our program, "Typing Club" to work on their skills. Note: Typing Club is only available to students in 2nd grade and above. Kinder and First grade students can utilize typing games and activities on websites such as www.todaysparent.com/family/fun-typing-games-for-kids/
